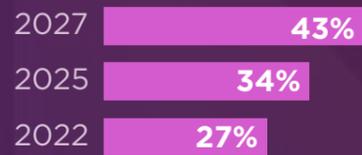

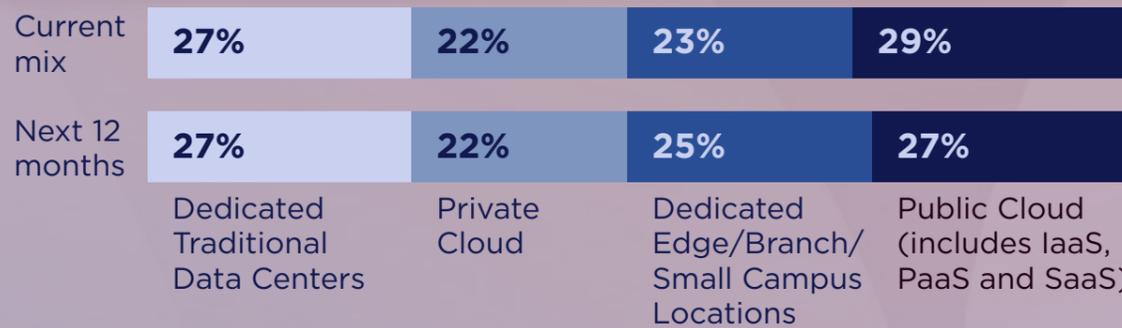

## Private Cloud Adoption Accelerates Shift to Hybrid / Multi-Cloud

Asia/Pacific organizations are investing in hybrid / multi-cloud with workload placement decisions, across myriad clouds, driven by application performance, speed, data sovereignty and business value metrics. Cost optimization is an important consideration for workload placement but not the only decision criteria.



Organizations are currently running 54% of their **mission-critical** workloads on traditional DC and private cloud infrastructure. Although the total mix for traditional DC and private cloud will remain unchanged in the next 12 months, private cloud will witness the biggest increase from 24% to 26%, while the share of public cloud will actually decline.

**63%** of organizations have repatriated some workloads back from public cloud to private cloud and/or traditional DC infrastructure

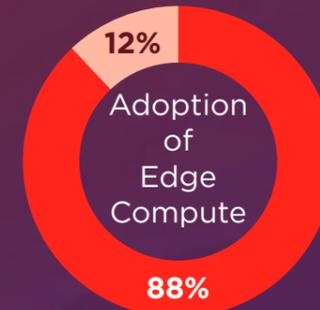


## Modern Data Management

**8%** of Asia/Pacific organizations have adopted single data management platform to manage data mobility across different clouds, integrating data in containers, for real-time seamless data mobility and provisioning to meet the most demanding business SLAs.

There is significant interest amongst Asia/Pacific organizations to adopt Edge compute to improve customer experience through analytics and to better manage / automate processes.

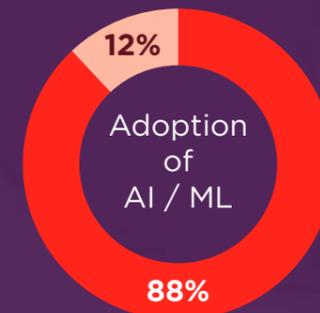
