Steps to Using Unsanded Grout

- Select grout color and add to specified volume of Flexible Admixture using a margin trowel or spiral mixer to avoid over-mixing.
- 2 Apply grout and use a grout float at a 45 degree angle to spread and remove excess grout from the face of the tile.
- Use a damp sponge to clean off excess grout from the tile; be sure to avoid watering down the grout which may change the color.
- Let the grout cure for 48—72 hours (if using Admixture) prior to applying sealer to the grout. Seal stone tile depending on customer selections.
- Apply caulk around fixtures, along terminating edges, and any inside corners between tile.

 [Always add powder into liquid when mixing.]
