

GROUT RELEASE

Grout Release is a water-soluble, pre-grout temporary coating that gives protection against grout and thinset staining, as well as eases in the grout cleanup process. It is most commonly used on rough, textured, porous stone and tile - or when using a darker grout with a lighter tile.

Key Features

- Protects against grout and thinset staining
- Accelerates and simplifies post-grouting cleanup

Installation

Packaging: 1 quart will cover 75 - 250 sq. ft.

Application Tips

- Prevent Grout Release buildup in grout joints
- Rubber gloves and eye protection should be worn during the application process
- Do not use acid solutions for clean up as it may react with Grout Release and form a residue
- Wait 48 hours to use if Grout was mixed with Admixture; wait 30 days if Grout was mixed with water
- Always test products in an inconspicuous area prior to general use

Steps to Apply Grout Release

- ① Use a scrubbing sponge to apply a liberal amount of Grout Release to ensure 100% surface coverage.
- ② Apply 2 coats using a scrubbing sponge wiping right to left on 1 coat; top to bottom on next.
- ③ Allow a minimum of 30 - 35 minutes of dry time before applying grout.
- ④ Mix grout with Flexible Grout Admixture. Use a float to work the grout into the joints.
- ⑤ Use the "Wipe-Flip-Wipe-Rinse" technique for clean up.
