Government agencies require a highly secure cloud environment to store and print documents for better collaboration and digitization. This can be accomplished by utilizing a FedRAMP-authorized Government Community Cloud (GCC) High environment.

imageRUNNER ADVANCE DX, imageFORCE, and imagePRESS Lite devices support the optional Authorized Send (ASEND) application. ASEND is an embedded, serverless MEAP application developed by Canon U.S.A. to help in the securing of the transmission of digital information from compatible Canon devices. ASEND can be configured to provide users one-touch access to their most frequently used scan workflows.

Scan to Microsoft 365 GCC High

One of the workflows ASEND offers is the ability for government users to process and route scan workflows to a single or multiple Microsoft 365 destinations, such as SharePoint, OneDrive, or Exchange, in a GCC High environment.

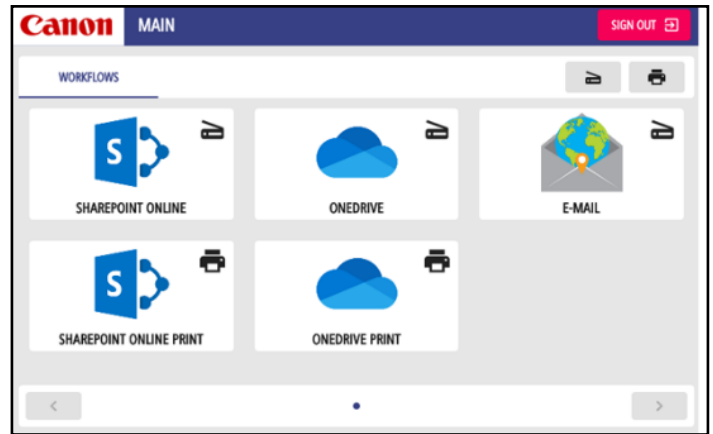
Print from Microsoft 365 GCC High

If an authorized user needs to print from their Microsoft 365 GCC High folder, ASEND allows them to access the document and print on the compatible Canon device. Supported file types include JPEG, TIFF, PDF, XPS, DOC, DOCX, PPT, PPTX, RTF, XLS, and XLSX.

Help Protect Communications – Authentication

CAC/PIV: When ASEND CAC/PIV is installed on the device, users can utilize 2-factor authentication (government issued cards and PIN) to authenticate and gain access to the scan and document distribution features. The CAC/PIV function is FIPS 140-2 certified.

RSA SecurID: For those users authenticating with RSA SecurID, when prompted they will enter their RSA SecurID username and passcode or username and passcode along with their Active Directory password.¹
