“uniFLOW Online distinguishes itself as a cloud platform that unifies secure printing, cost controls, and scan workflows within one console,” said Keith Haas, Solutions Analyst in Keypoint Intelligence’s Workplace Group. “In testing, Remote Device Access and the macOS client eased support across dispersed sites, while enforced MFA, six-digit PIN defaults, and audit redaction improved walk-up security. The Virtual Printer App enabled a driver free route for Windows Protected Print, and Teams and NetDocuments integrations sped capture and routing.”

Organizations often rely on separate tools for print management, mobile submission, secure release, and scan routing, which increases overhead. uniFLOW Online brings those pieces into a cloud service, removing on-premises server dependencies while supporting Windows, macOS, iOS, and Android users. During Keypoint testing, it handled mixed fleets of Canon devices alongside select Lexmark and Sharp models, and the platform connected securely to identities and cloud repositories. Whether teams file to Microsoft 365 destinations such as SharePoint or to services like OneDrive, Box, or Google Drive, routing stays consistent. Stronger reporting, cost-center allocation, and automatic budgets help leaders track usage and cut waste, and UI refinements clarified queues.

“Beyond the improvements to workflows, uniFLOW Online provides administrative controls that help organizations keep policy, access, and spend aligned as they expand across locations,” Haas said. “Secure external support access and tenant level permissions simplify remote issue resolution without weakening governance, and multi-instance Microsoft 365 and Exchange connections reduce destination confusion for users. With scheduled report filtering, cost center pricing, and automatic budget management, stakeholders gain clearer oversight of activity. These advantages, paired with consistent experiences across mixed fleets, make uniFLOW Online a strong choice for cloud print and capture.”
