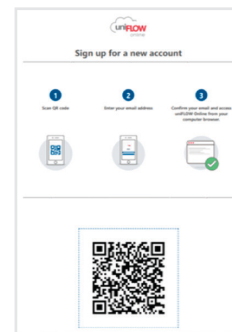
Public User Registration



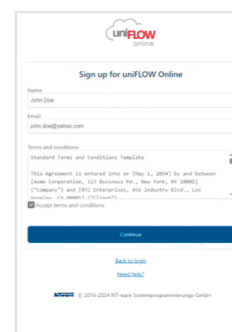
Users with an **unknown email domain** can now **self-register**—there is **no limit to the number of email domains**.

To identify the user, a pop-up will appear, prompting for an email address or card number.

The print job can be retrieved at the device after authentication.

uniFLOW Online's public printing feature is available for device-based tenants with a Cloud Print & Scan Subscription. To enable the public printing feature, administrators must acknowledge that the organization offering the public sign-up service will act as a "Data Processor" in compliance with regional regulations.
