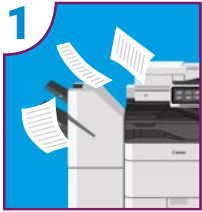

Consolidated Reporting, No Matter Where the Devices are Located.

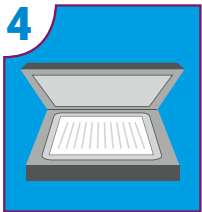
