Simplify Print Infrastructure

uniFLOW Online simplifies IT administration with Universal Print, which moves central Microsoft Windows Server print infrastructure to the Microsoft 365 cloud for robust and centralized print management capabilities. IT administrators can register printers in Azure Active Directory and publish location and other attributes so that healthcare staff can easily discover a nearby preconfigured printer, add the printer, and simply print. In a hybrid configuration, uniFLOW Online and uniFLOW (on-premise) can work together. This is ideal for environments that need a tighter security profile for certain departments or require the extended functionality available through the on-premise version coupled with flexible uniFLOW online features to support satellite locations or minimum-risk departments.

Print from Epic

The uniFLOW Epic App Connector simplifies printing from Epic by connecting directly to Epic Electronic Health Record systems or to local print servers. The uniFLOW Epic App Connector is available for uniFLOW (on-premise) and uniFLOW One installations via the Epic App Marketplace.

Reduce IT Burden

With uniFLOW solutions, administrators have a single set of login credentials for end users, a single point of reporting and budget control, and a single solution for printing across facilities. The modular architecture allows IT departments to purchase only essential functionality.

Print from Anywhere

uniFLOW Online allows healthcare staff to use compatible smartphones or tablets to submit and release their print jobs wherever healthcare work is done. All scheduled print jobs appear in their personal Secure Print Queue where they can be tracked, audited, charged, and managed according to established policies. Users can even register multiple email addresses, allowing them to submit jobs from personal and work email accounts. This is especially useful in hybrid work environments as well as for staff who work across multiple facilities or in home healthcare locations.

SUBSTANTIVE CONTROL

Healthcare organizations choose uniFLOW to help facilitate security and compliance efforts, gain visibility into usage and utilization data, track individual output activities, enable staff to print more securely, help reduce IT overhead, and improve sustainability.

Protect Confidential Patient Data

uniFLOW solutions empower administrators to limit multifunction printer access to only authorized healthcare professionals and users via proximity card login, PIN code, or job code. They can also be granted different access rights to multifunction device (MFD) functions depending on their job role. This can help mitigate the risk of data breaches by making print, scan, copy, and fax² functionality unavailable to unauthorized staff and visitors.

Print and Release

uniFLOW solutions help administrators implement Secure Print and job release at connected Canon or non-Canon devices from supported desktops, laptops, tablets, and mobile phones. Users can authenticate at the device to release print jobs from their personal secure print queue, thus helping reduce the risk of sensitive documents sitting in the printer output tray and falling into the wrong hands.

Encourage Cost-conscious Behavior

With uniFLOW solutions, you can track your organization's printing, copying, scanning, and faxing* costs and generate analytical reports that offer insights into who is printing, what is being printed, and how much that printing costs. The detailed tracking and activity reports can be used to help to analyze device usage and identify opportunities to save resources and influence responsible printing and copying behavior.

EFFICIENT INTEROPERABILITY

As healthcare organizations strive to use data in new ways, there is an increased need to rapidly digitize, classify, and store information more efficiently wherever healthcare work is done. uniFLOW solutions can integrate with existing healthcare applications, automate time-consuming indexing processes, and track and audit printing among remote workers in hybrid work environments.

Scan to Information Repositories

Entering critical paper-based information into Electronic Health Record (EHR), revenue cycle management, and other enterprise systems is a time-consuming process. uniFLOW solutions enable healthcare staff to create individual scan workflows including automatic detection of scanned document type, automatic extraction of key data, and online database validations that can be integrated with (third-party) back-office systems. This contributes to easy storage, search, and retrieval of patient, payer, and employee records.

Once information is captured and processed, uniFLOW solutions³ enable users to easily distribute documents to a variety of destinations, including Microsoft SharePoint®/SharePoint® Online, Microsoft Teams®, Laserfiche, Therefore™/Therefore™ Online, RightFax, or Hyland OnBase® as well as to popular, cloud-based destinations such as Microsoft® OneDrive®/OneDrive® for Business, Box, Google Drive™, or Dropbox™, and to local network folders.

an optional secure cloud print-and-scan solution that enables organizations to manage their entire print environment without the need to invest in or manage local servers.

On-premise uniFLOW

an optional server-based, enterprise-level print and scan management solution that provides a single print-and-scan platform for healthcare organizations.





ADDITIONAL uniFLOW OPTIONS

Select organizations may choose to incorporate both uniFLOW Online and on-premise uniFLOW (server-based) solutions to create a “uniFLOW hybrid environment” for distributed workforces or facilities.
